competition the requirements for a CH title to be eligible for Grand Championship (GCH) BOB competition based upon the owners' records of their having completed A dog must be (1) a Champion of Record or (2) have been transferred to

defeated at three of these shows. under at least four different judges. Also at least one Champion of Record must be one other judge must award some of the remaining points - so you need to win Champion. The majors must be won under three different judges and at least three major wins (a major win is worth three points or higher) to become a Grand The American Kennel Club requires a dog to obtain a total of 25 points with

Select Dog - SD; Select Bitch - SB Best of Breed - BOB; Best of Opposite Sex - BOS

Remember, point schedules vary by show location. If you are not at the show, Refer to the Schedule of Points. make certain you get the points schedule for the event region where your dog won

Check the posted copies of the judge's book before you leave the show to make certain your dog was marked correctly. Mistakes do happen! Also, verify that your dog's AKC registration number is correct in the catalog. If it is not correct, let the superintendent know before you leave the show. In both cases, if's easier to make the correction on the day of the show rather than later. point schedules that are used for the calculation of championship (CH) points.
